What Are The Requirements?

Women of any nationality are eligible. Applicants must:

- * Be registered in an accredited Ph.D./doctoral program in a qualifying area of science or engineering closely related to advanced studies in aerospace-related science or aerospace-related engineering
- * Demonstrate a superior academic record
- Provide evidence of a well-defined research program in aerospace-related science or aerospace-related engineering and clearly demonstrate the relationship of your research to aerospace
- Be registered in a full time Ph.D./doctorate program when funds are received in September (students pursuing a post-doctoral research program are not elligible)
